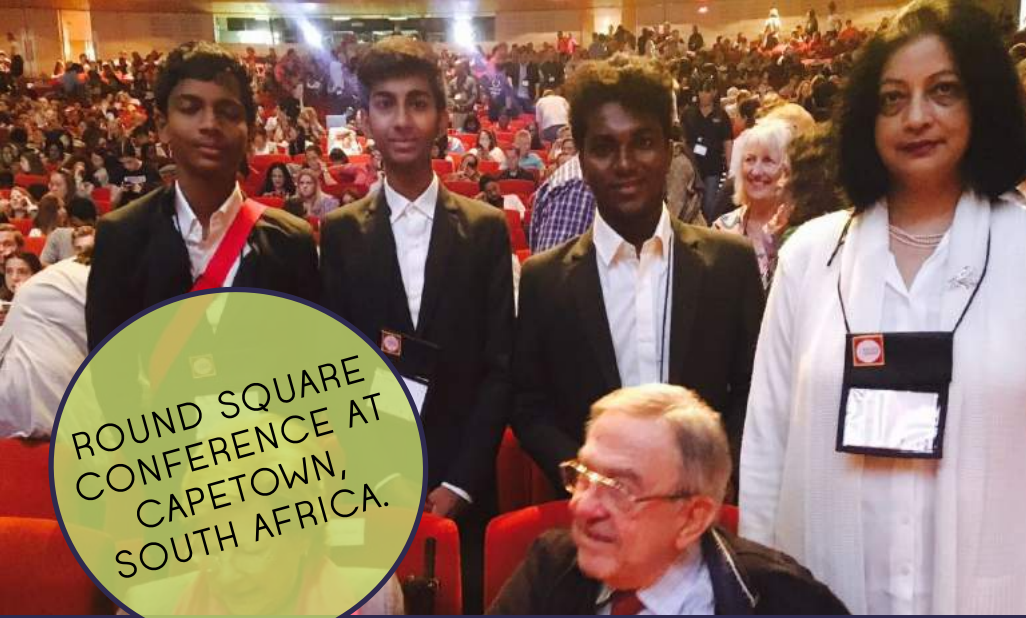

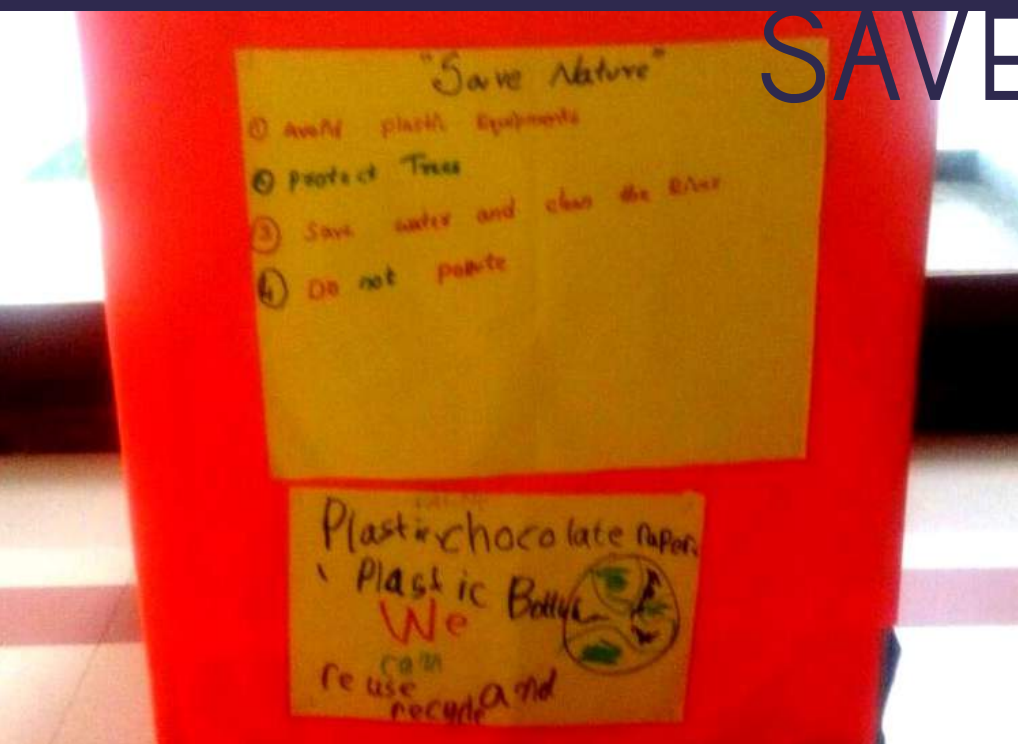
# CHESHIRE HOME

The students of grade 5 interacted with Ajmera Global School, Mumbai through Skype on their UOI (Unit of Inquiry) - Government Systems.



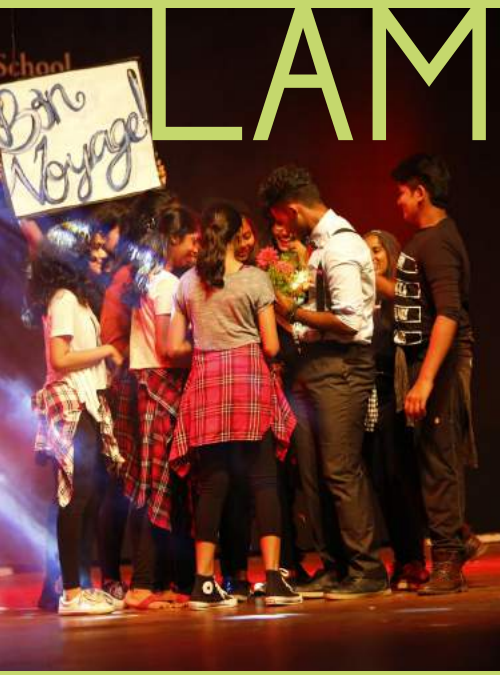
