












## **Academic scholarships**

Our batch of 2023 have taken up - or are about to commence - courses at leading universities, including Vellore Institute of Technology, Manipal Institute of Technology, Ashoka University, Christ University Bangalore, Marian College Trivandrum and the Manipal Academy of Higher Education in India; in the United States: Georgia Tech, the University of Illinois Urbana Champaign, the University of Cincinnati, Stony Brook University and the University of Washington, Seattle; TRINS graduates will join Western University, Canada, University College Roosevelt, the Netherlands and the University of Bath, UK.
