DP Results-Batch of 2023







The IBDP Batch of 2023 received their Diploma results on Thursday, 6th July, marking the completion of the two-year learning journey. We are proud of all our IBDP students for a great performance, those awarded the full Diploma achieving an average of 32 against the global average of 30.2. Eleven of these twenty scored 33 or above, with seven 7s (the top mark possible for a subject) and twenty three 6s. Our school toppers are Siddhartha Chakilam (39 points); Mathew Thomas (36 points) and Pooja Gopal (35 points).

This is an opportunity to celebrate the hard work put in by our students who had experienced the many challenges through the Covid years. TRINS is proud of all the DP students who have reached this milestone. This would not have been possible without the unstinting effort and dedication of our teachers, led by Ms. Rachel Jacob (DPC), and the support of the whole school community
