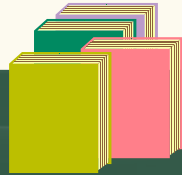

BOOK FAIR BY "BOOK BERRIES"

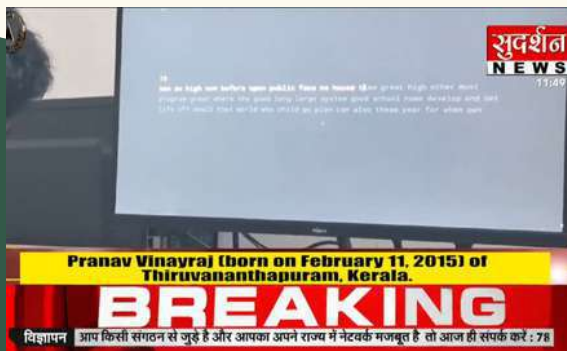
