



He also introduced self-protection tactics in emergency situations, road safety, shared key emergency contact numbers such as the national police hotline and child safety cell, and discussed the critical distinction between good-touch and badtouch. His engaging approach and ability to connect with the children helped dispel any fears about the police, leaving a lasting, positive impression on everyone.










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
