Overall, out of 379 individual grades issued, our students have achieved a grade of A or A* in 167 and B in 114 papers – thereby resulting in a Grade of B and above in approximately 74% of the total individual grades. These results are a product of the hard work and

sincerity of both staff and students and I would like to congratulate them for their efforts.
