### Principal's Message:

The **IBDP May 2025** results were released on **July 6th**. Over **2,02,000** students worldwide had undertaken exams in **May 2025**, out of which **81.26%** have achieved the **IB Diploma**. It is my pleasure to share with you that students at **TRINS** have achieved excellent results, a brief summary of which is presented below -

- Average Diploma Score of **34.63** as compared to the global average Diploma score of **30.58**.
- Diploma rate of **96%** as compared to the global average of **81.26%**.
- Approximately **32%** of our students have achieved a score of **38** and above (out of a possible 45).
- **Top score - 44**
- Approximately 90% of the students have received a minimum of **2 points** (out of the possible 3) in their core components (Extended essay + TOK) demonstrating strong research and critical thinking skills.

The fact that the average Diploma score at **TRINS (34.63)** is significantly higher than the world average **IB Diploma score (30.58)** is a testament to the hard work and dedication of both our teachers and students and the leadership demonstrated by our IBDP Coordinator, Ms. Rachel.

This week, we also witnessed the inauguration of the **Tinkering Lab** for the **PYP**. Tinkering is essential in schools – it encourages creativity and ignites curiosity. However, it is also important to emphasize that tinkering should not be restricted to the tinkering lab. Every space in the school should be a safe place where students are encouraged to explore creativity without fear of judgement and failure. This is vital to our mission of “**learning for life**” and equips students for handling an unknown future.
