




#### The DP Core

IB Diploma Programme: Preparing Global Thinkers

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) at TRINS is designed to challenge and inspire students, equipping them with the skills and knowledge needed for success in higher education and beyond. With a balanced curriculum that emphasises academic depth and breadth, the DP nurtures critical thinking, research skills, and international-mindedness. Students engage with core components such as the Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE), and Creativity Activity Service (CAS) while choosing subjects that align with their interests and career goals. This holistic approach prepares students to thrive as compassionate, informed, and adaptable global citizens.



## CAREER COUNSELLING & UNIVERSITY GUIDANCE

At Trins, formal career discussions start in middle school, with the form teachers conducting activities in class about interests, aspirations, jobs, success, extra curriculars and so on.

In high school (9, 10), a career counselling lesson is scheduled in the weekly timetable. The topics discussed include subject choices, career options, profile building, universities, courses, choice of curriculum in senior school, how to plan backwards to enable informed subject choices. Subject experts (teachers) also visit the lesson and talk about their subject/career.

In senior school, discussions are focussed on university choices, programme choices, writing personal statements, admission requirements, profile enhancement. University representatives visit and address the students as well.

We are a PSAT, SAT & AP Exam Centres as well.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

At TRINS, the Admission Counselling Team is dedicated to supporting families in making the best educational choices for their children. Our goal is to ensure your child's success throughout the admissions process and beyond. Admission at TRINS has a five step process.

#### Eligibility -

- Applicants must meet the age criteria.
- Submission of the past two years' scholastic & co-curricular records is mandatory.
- A copy of the birth certificate or passport is required.

#### **Application**

All eligible candidates can apply through the application form available on the TRINS website.
 All necessary documents must be submitted for application processing.

#### Assessment -

- Applicants appear for a Proficiency Test and Personal Interview.
- Performance in the test, previous records, and the interview will determine admission.

#### Interaction

- Families are encouraged to visit the school while classes are in session.
- If visiting is not possible, interactions can be arranged via phone or Skype.

#### Decision

• The decision to admit will be made by the Coordinator/Section Head and Principal.
