## **Student Internship Programme**

As an endeavour to provide a platform for our students to discover their passions and interests, we have introduced the pilot internship programme during the Christmas break from 18th to 22nd December. We had reached out to our parent community asking if they would be willing to accommodate our students for the experience in their companies. The students of Grade 11 gave their fields of interest and based on that they were connected with 9 companies/offices in Trivandrum. Some spent time at Government offices understanding forensics and court activities, others got experiences of up to two weeks in medical or business settings.
