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Student Achievements

The 2024 batch of Diploma Programme students have received their results. We celebrate their success with them. Students study six subjects, as well as a core programme, and receive a point score, with 45 points being the maximum possible. Globally, the average point score for a DP candidate in 2024 is 30.32; the TRINS average point score is 34.

Our school toppers, who scored 40 points, are Mathew George and Joshua Mario Joseph. Congratulations to them and all their classmates. Many have already secured places at leading universities in India and abroad, whilst there are others who are still to finalise their university plans. We are proud of each student and look forward to following their future path.

Ms Rachel Jacob, the Diploma Programme Coordinator, and all the DP teachers are fundamental to this story of success. This is the largest DP batch we have had to date, and each student is able to relate stories of how their teachers have helped them confront and overcome obstacles both in their academics and more broadly. 



